Facilities: The Doris Leeper Spruce Creek Preserve consists of more than 2479 acres in Volusia County, FL of which this 600-acre area consists of a mosaic of varying habitat and soil types. This park is primitive with NO ELECTRICITY OTHER THAN YOUR GENERATORS. All rules of the preserve must be observed. Anyone breaking these rules may be asked to leave. No firearms or narcotics are permitted in the preserve. Please leave the grounds as clean as you found them – remove hay or place it in woods, and really spread the manure! A convenience store is four miles away for ice and fuel intersection of Pioneer Trail and Sugar Mill Roads.

Camping - NO Camping 2021 Spring - Covid-THERE ARE LOCAL PLACES NEARBY WITH STALLS OR PADDOCKS/camp with your horse(s) and electric hookups (Flying B Ranch). Gate opens at 6 am for arrival. Ride management will check temperatures of people, review Coggins and Covid plan, provide ride card,

trail and vet information will be emailed in advance and posted. Completion awards will be provided upon vet in.

VET IN IS IN ORDER THAT ENTRIES WERE RECEIVED – although if you are late, then we move to next person! There is plenty of grassy pasture with open fields and areas under wonderful old trees. Bring your PEOPLE water and your food (no meals) – there is horse water available. Portable Paddocks, tie to your trailer, or High-Ties may be utilized. Please do not tie directly to trees or fences! There is ONE hose that is near the vet check area but no hosing your horse during the ride as it's needed to refill water tanks. You may rinse them afterwards. NEW NORMAL – PARK 20 FEET INCLUDING YOUR PADDOCKS/PENS from any other trailer (day riders may be present also). Do NOT camp on top of any disk golf holes please so stay on the left side of the road in the field when you drive in!

Entry Requirements: Pre-entry REQUIRED for all rides with full payment received by March 16, 2021. We want to be Rider friendly, but there is no registration office on site. Contact RM if you have a justifiable exception. EVERYONE COMING WITH YOU MUST SIGN WAIVERS. Meals: None

Rules: COVID PLAN in place and MASKS/FACE COVERINGS must be worn in vet check area and failure to comply may result in disqualification. Please bring your own! All USEF, AERC, SEDRA, and SERA rules apply. Decisions of the vets are final. To receive credit for completing the ride, horses must be "fit to continue", is determined by the veterinarians. JUNIORS must be accompanied by an adult sponsor 18 years or older. Everyone must show a current AERC card or pay the \$15 non-member fee, and this applies to juniors. 25-mile horses must be 4 years old, 50-mile horses must be 5 years old. ALL RIDERS MUST

Lastly, please be kind to volunteers and officials!

FEES: <u>AERC 25/50 miles</u> \$120.00 Adults; young riders are \$80; Juniors are \$60 and Intro Riders \$50.00. ONCE YOU VET IN, THERE ARE NO REFUNDS and if you pre-register and do not cancel two weeks out, a \$35 cancellation fee applies as we have ordered shirts, prizes, and vets based on these numbers. Multiple intro rides each day. You may successfully complete one IDR and then start the next IDR with vet approval.

**Tentative Schedule of Events:** 50 Mile/25 Mile rides start at 7:30 am together and Intro riders start around 9 AM (earlier if you are riding with a friend in the LD/50 mile distances) or later as you need to vet in after the 25/50 horses. The afternoon LD starts at 1:00 (ESTIMATED) so come in plenty of time to vet in before your start. Check in with timer 15 minutes BEFORE your start. You can leave late but check-in 15 minutes before your time starts, on foot or on the horse, you may start late but check in on time! *Times*,

officials and loops subject to change check on-site as we all must vet in each morning – so bring your patience with you!

**Awards:** No awards ceremony with Covid. Best condition, top ten, first Junior awards are available for pick up at pavillion after successful completion. You must sign that received your award – we will NOT mail any awards to you so please pick them up! We will try to post placings by the pavilion.

**Trails:** All trails loop back to camp with no away vet checks. Sandy trails, predominantly two-track with some single track through the woods and dirt roads with roots! It is a barefoot friendly trail! These are MULTI-USE trails – NEVER GO ON PERMANENT MARKED BLUE TRAILS (BICYCLES).

<u>Directions: IF YOU USE GPS, YOU MUST TURN AT THE ORANGE FOREST GATE when you see ride sign. 2317 CREEK SHORE TRAIL, NEW SMYRNA, FL</u> From I-95, take exit #249 New Smyrna Beach, SR #44 – Go east about 0.4 miles towards New Smyrna and take the FIRST left at caution light onto Sugar Mill Road. In 1.4 miles, Sugar Mill Road comes to a 4-way stop sign. Go left onto Pioneer Trail for 1.7 miles. Go right onto Turnbull Bay Road. Go 2.15 miles and turn left onto Creek Shore Trail. Entrance to the preserve is 1.45 miles on left through an orange 'forest' gate.

From I-4 take exit 118, SR #44 East towards New Smyrna Beach. In about 7.2 miles turn LEFT onto CR 4118 which is Pioneer Trail. In about 4 miles, you come to a 4 way intersection (Cabbage Patch Sopotnik's Bar on left corner. Stop and continue STRAIGHT still on Pioneer Trail, CR 4118. Go 4.1 miles (go over I95 but there is no exit there) to QUICK LEFT ON CURVE - Turnbull Bay Road. Go 2.15 miles and turn left onto Creek Shore Trail. The entrance to the preserve is 1.45 miles on the left through an orange 'forest' gate.

**NEARBY CAMPING:** Flying B Ranch is located approximately five miles away on Pioneer Trail. The address is 686 North Samsula Drive, New Smyna Beach, FL 32168. Phone: 386-478-1244 They have electrical hookups, paddocks or stalls for your horses. You can keep your horses at Flying B and stay in a hotel or camp onsite with them. You can be at the ride site in about 15 minutes each morning.

This document waives very important legal rights. Read it carefully before signing. I understand that distance riding involves being in remote areas for extended periods of time, far from communications, transportation, and medical facilities; that these areas have many natural and man-made hazards, which ride management cannot anticipate, identify, modify, or eliminate; that horses can be excitable, difficult to control, and unpredictable, and that accidents can happen to anyone at any time. I agree to take full responsibility for myself and the animal I am riding. This release is also valid for my animals, personal belongings, family members, any guests or crew in my company. Under FL law, an equine sponsor or equine professional is not liable for an injury to, or the death of, a participant in equine activities resulting from the inherent risks of equine activities (FL Statute 773.01-773.06).

I shall hold the following list of individuals and entities blameless and free from liability, to the fullest extent allowed by law, for any accident, injury or loss that might occur due to my participation in the ride. To be very clear, I shall not pursue any legal action or other form of action against the following: the ride management, Central Florida Horse Shows, Volusia County, AERC, SEDRA, and SERA all ride personnel, all veterinarians and related treatments, the State of Florida, the landowners of the base camp, and all property owners over whose land the ride crosses. I have read and understand this liability release. I understand that this Release applies for the entire ride; from arrival at Spruce Creek Preserve, during the ride and until removal of all animals and personal property from the ride site.

B. ACKNOWLEDGMENT OF RISK: I knowingly, willingly, and voluntarily acknowledge the inherent risks associated with the sport of equestrian and know that horseback riding and related equestrian activities are inherently dangerous, and that participation in any USEF Event involves risks and dangers including, without limitation, the potential for serious bodily injury (including broken bones, head or neck injuries), sickness and disease (including communicable diseases), trauma, pain & suffering, permanent disability, paralysis and death; loss of or damage to personal property (including my mount & equipment) arising out of the unpredictable behavior of horses; exposure to extreme conditions and circumstances; accidents involving other participants, event staff, volunteers or spectators; contact or collision with other participants and horses, natural or manmade objects; adverse weather conditions; facilities issues and premises conditions; failure of protective equipment (including helmets); inadequate safety measures; participants of varying skill levels; situations beyond the immediate control of the USEF Event organizers and competition management; and other undefined, not readily foreseeable and presently unknown risks and dangers ("Risks").

#### WARNING:

Under Florida law, an equine activity sponsor or equine professional is not liable for an injury to, or the death of, a participant in equine activities resulting from the inherent risks of equine activities.

C. ASSUMPTION OF RISK: I understand that the aforementioned Risks may be caused in whole or in part or result directly or indirectly from the negligence of my own actions or inactions, the actions or inactions of others participating in the USEF Events, or the negligent acts or omissions of the Released Parties defined below, and I hereby voluntarily and knowingly assume all such Risks and responsibility for any damages, liabilities, losses, or expenses that I incur as a result of my participation in any USEF Events. I also agree to be responsible for any injury or damage caused by me, my horse, my employees or contractors under my direction and control at any USEF Event.

D. #### **COVID 19 PLAN FOR RIDES IN FLORIDA**

<u>REGISTRATION</u> – Registration should be done in advance by snail with payment and waivers received 14 days (weekends count) before the ride. <u>EVERY PERSON IN YOUR VEHICLE OR COMING WITH YOU TO INCLUDE VOLUNTEERS, OWNERS, CREW MUST SIGN A WAIVER</u>. In cases with justifiable reasons, late registrations may be considered by RM. There will not be a registration office open on site. If you plan to register late with advance written approval, you must arrive with a hard copy of entry form, waivers for all people, coggins and payment before you unload!

<u>SIGNS</u> – about CDC recommendations about the symptoms of Covid 19 and how to prevent its spread will be posted along with camp rules (e.g. no chewing gum, masks/face coverings in camp that you must provide).

#### **ARRIVAL** – When people arrive:

- 1. Human temperatures will be checked and no one with a temperature of 99.9 or higher will be allowed to unload at the venue.
- 2. Each person in the vehicle must confirm they have not had a positive COVID 19 test or been exposed to a person with COVID 19 in the last 14 days.
- 3. Anyone with COVID symptoms cannot attend the event.
- 4. Participants from out of state venues (e.g New York, New Jersey, CT, LA) that must self-quarantine upon arrival as identified in the most recent executive order from the Governor of the state will not be allowed to participate in the ride. They will be asked to leave, and this will be spelled out in the entry form.
- 5. The completion award of a thermometer for self-temperature monitoring (or a T-shirt if people have their own thermometer already) will be given to the rider.
- 6. Ride cards will be kept at the vet check filed by distance/rider number. The rider may view their ride card before they leave the vet check each time. For AERC riders, they should leave a stamped self-addressed envelope and their ride card will be mailed to them.
- 7. The trail directions and vet talk will be provided by hard copy upon arrival. Maps/colors of the trail loops will be posted near the timer tent and people may social distance and take photos of the trails if they wish.

<u>CAMPING</u> —<u>Each camper must park at least 20 feet away from other primitive campers to INCLUDE the portable pens, vehicles, and other belongings.</u>

SANITIZERS – will be available in multiple locations including arrival into the vet check, and crew areas.

<u>FACE COVERINGS/MASKS</u> – must be worn in camp unless you are mounted on a horse, unless you are at your trailer. Masks are provided to all volunteers and officials, but riders/crew must bring their own.

NO RIDE MEETING or MEALS provided, only written information provided upon arrival.

<u>TRAILS</u> – Social distancing should be practiced on horseback. Riders should only pass someone when you have plenty of room to safely pass with 10 feet of space between you and other riders. At water stops, wear your mask if you are not the only one there. Failure to comply may result in disqualification from the ride.


<u>VET CHECKS/CREWING</u> – Flakes of hay will be spaced 10 feet apart going into the pulse box and vet check. You should practice social distancing in the vet check and in the crew areas. Crew locations must be spread out to be 10 feet between anyone not in your group.

<u>AWARDS</u> – No prize giving ceremony will be held. You may pick up any awards between designated times using social distancing techniques wearing face coverings.
